

## Parent Report Card Information

**Q:** What guidelines were used in developing the new report card?

**A:** The state of New Hampshire Grade Level Expectations and the Manchester School District curriculum were used in creating the documents.

**Q:** Where do you find more information on the bulleted math items?

**A:** You can view it on the Manchester School District website under the parent link.

**Q:** Why are the progress indicators used on the report card?

**A:** The progress indicators correlate with the New England Common Assessment Program (NECAP). This test is given each year in October to students in grades 3-5.

**Q:** Why does my child have a need of improvement checkmark next to attendances and tardiness?

**A:** Your child was absent or tardy 20% of the trimester if he or she received a checkmark.

**Q:** If I move to another Manchester school will the report card be the same?

**A:** Yes. The report card is being used in all Manchester elementary schools.

**Q:** Who gives my child their grade for health, music, art, and P.E.?

**A:** Each specialist provides the grade for their own content area.
